2 **Anne Arundel County – Environmental Health Monitoring – Reimbursement**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of the Environment ~~and the~~
5 ~~Department of Natural Resources~~ to reimburse Anne Arundel County for the
6 cost of certain environmental health monitoring and testing under certain
7 circumstances; requiring a reimbursement only if a certain fine is collected;
8 limiting the amount of a reimbursement to a certain amount; providing that
9 this Act shall apply retroactively only to certain costs incurred by Anne Arundel
10 County; and generally relating to requiring reimbursement of Anne Arundel
11 County for the cost of certain environmental health monitoring and testing.
