4 FOR the purpose of including certain types of instruction as satisfying certain
5 education requirements for licensure as a real estate salesperson; and generally
6 relating to the education requirements for licensure as a real estate salesperson.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Business Occupations and Professions**

20 17–303.

1 (a) To qualify for a real estate salesperson license, an applicant shall be an
2 individual who meets the requirements of this section.

3 (d) An applicant shall have completed successfully:

4 (1) a basic course in real estate approved by the Commission that:

5 (i) does not require more than 60 clock hours of:

6 1. classroom instruction; OR

7 2. INSTRUCTION PROVIDED BY:

8 A. REMOTE ACCESS SATELLITE;

9 B. CLOSED-CIRCUIT VIDEO;

10 C. COMPUTER, INCLUDING TRANSMISSION OVER THE
11 INTERNET AND THE WORLD WIDE WEB;

12 D. HOME STUDY; OR

13 E. ANY OTHER DELIVERY SYSTEM APPROVED BY THE
14 COMMISSION; and

15 (ii) includes a 3 clock hour course in real estate ethics approved
16 by the Commission; or

17 (2) if approved by the Commission as an alternative, courses in real
18 estate subjects in any college, including a 3 clock hour course in real estate ethics
19 approved by the Commission.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
21 October 1, 2008.
