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1 INSURER, NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLAN, OR HEALTH MAINTENANCE 2 **ORGANIZATION.** 3 EACH MEMBER OF A PHARMACY AND THERAPEUTICS **(D)** (1) 4 **COMMITTEE OF A PHARMACY BENEFITS MANAGER SHALL BE:** $\mathbf{5}$ **(I)** A PHYSICIAN OR OTHER AUTHORIZED PRESCRIBER, A 6 PHARMACIST, OR A FACULTY MEMBER OF AN ACADEMIC MEDICAL CENTER; AND $\mathbf{7}$ **(II)** DISCLOSED BY NAME TO THE PURCHASER ON REQUEST. 8 (2) A MAJORITY OF COMMITTEE MEMBERS MAY NOT BE 9 **EMPLOYED BY THE PHARMACY BENEFITS MANAGER.** 10 **(E)** A PHARMACY AND THERAPEUTICS COMMITTEE MEMBER MAY NOT: 11 (1) BE AN OFFICER, EMPLOYEE, DIRECTOR, OR AGENT OF A 12PHARMACEUTICAL MANUFACTURER; OR 13 HAVE A FINANCIAL INTEREST IN A PHARMACEUTICAL **(2)** 14 MANUFACTURER, OTHER THAN OWNERSHIP OF A NOMINAL NUMBER OF SHARES 15OF THE PHARMACEUTICAL MANUFACTURER'S STOCK, PURCHASED ON A 16 NATIONAL SECURITIES EXCHANGE. 17 **(F)** (1) A PHARMACY BENEFITS MANAGER MAY NOT REQUIRE A 18 PHARMACY TO PARTICIPATE IN A PHARMACY AND THERAPEUTICS COMMITTEE. 19 (2) IF A PHARMACY AGREES TO PARTICIPATE IN A PHARMACY 20AND THERAPEUTICS COMMITTEE, THE PHARMACY BENEFITS MANAGER SHALL 21REIMBURSE ANY EXPENSES INCURRED BY THE PHARMACY AS A RESULT OF ITS 22**PARTICIPATION.** 23ON OR BEFORE APRIL 1, 2009, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ADOPT (G) 24**REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS SECTION.** 25THE COMMISSIONER MAY ASSESS A CIVIL PENALTY NOT EXCEEDING **(H)** 26 **\$5,000** FOR EACH VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION.
