- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Higher Education Commission to require 4 all institutions of higher education to require certain students to maintain and 5 present evidence of health care coverage throughout a certain period; requiring 6 the Commission to require the institutions of higher education to offer health 7 insurance for purchase by students and consider health care coverage as an 8 educational cost for a certain purpose; requiring the Commission to adopt 9 certain regulations; providing for the implementation of certain requirements of 10 this Act; defining a certain term; and generally relating to health care coverage requirements for students enrolled in institutions of higher education. 11

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the requirements of § 11–1001(b), as enacted by Section 1 of this Act, shall be implemented beginning in the fall 2009 semester.
