A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Energy Consumer Protection Act

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a certain electricity supplier from preventing an 4 electric company that is affiliated with the electricity supplier from constructing 5 or acquiring a certain electric generating station and associated transmission 6 lines under certain circumstances; authorizing a county or municipal 7 corporation to construct or acquire an electric generating station and associated 8 transmission lines or contract with an outside entity for the construction or 9 acquisition and management of an electric generating station and associated transmission lines under certain circumstances; requiring the construction or 10 11 acquisition of a certain electric generating station and associated transmission lines to be made in accordance with certain provisions of law; requiring a 12 certain electricity supplier that operates a nuclear power plant in the State to 13 14 offer to sell to certain electric companies certain wholesale electricity at the lowest best price at which the supplier sells electricity to certain customers 15located outside the State; requiring a certain electricity supplier that operates a 16 nuclear power plant in the State to make a certain report to the Public Service 17Commission each year; and generally relating to the generation and sale of 18 electricity. 19

2 AN ELECTRICITY SUPPLIER THAT IS AFFILIATED WITH AN ELECTRIC 3 COMPANY IN THIS STATE MAY NOT PREVENT THE AFFILIATED ELECTRIC 4 COMPANY FROM CONSTRUCTING OR ACQUIRING AN ELECTRIC GENERATING 5 STATION AND ASSOCIATED TRANSMISSION LINES IN THIS STATE.

6 **7–214.**

7 (A) A COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION MAY CONSTRUCT OR 8 ACQUIRE AN ELECTRIC GENERATING STATION AND ASSOCIATED TRANSMISSION 9 LINES OR CONTRACT WITH AN OUTSIDE ENTITY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OR 10 ACQUISITION AND MANAGEMENT OF AN ELECTRIC GENERATING STATION AND 11 ASSOCIATED TRANSMISSION LINES.

(B) THE CONSTRUCTION OR ACQUISITION OF AN ELECTRIC
 GENERATING STATION AND ASSOCIATED TRANSMISSION LINES IN ACCORDANCE
 WITH THIS SECTION SHALL BE MADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF
 THIS ARTICLE.

16 **7–510.1.**

(A) AN ELECTRICITY SUPPLIER THAT IS OPERATING A NUCLEAR POWER
PLANT IN THE STATE MUST OFFER TO SELL TO EACH ELECTRIC COMPANY
OPERATING IN THE STATE WHOLESALE ELECTRICITY GENERATED AT THE
NUCLEAR POWER PLANT AT THE LOWEST BEST PRICE THAT THE ELECTRICITY
SUPPLIER SELLS THE ELECTRICITY GENERATED AT THE NUCLEAR POWER
PLANT TO ANY WHOLESALE OR INDUSTRIAL CUSTOMERS LOCATED OUTSIDE THE
STATE.

(B) EACH YEAR, EVERY ELECTRICITY SUPPLIER THAT IS OPERATING A
 NUCLEAR POWER PLANT IN THE STATE SHALL REPORT TO THE COMMISSION
 ON:

27(1) THE TOTAL GENERATING CAPACITY OF THE NUCLEAR POWER28PLANT;

29(2) THE AMOUNT OF ENERGY ACTUALLY PRODUCED AT THE30NUCLEAR POWER PLANT; AND

31 (3) THE AMOUNT OF ENERGY PRODUCED AT THE NUCLEAR
 32 POWER PLANT THAT IS SOLD TO ELECTRIC COMPANIES OPERATING IN THE
 33 STATE.
