"Naturalized" means documented as having lived, grown, and 5 **(6)** reproduced in State waters for more than 10 years without known harm to the 6 7 ecosystem. "Nonnative" means other than native or naturalized. 8 (7)9 "Nuisance organism" means a nonnative OR NATURALIZED (8)aquatic organism that will foreseeably alter and threaten to harm the ecosystem or the 10 abundance and diversity of native or naturalized fish and other organisms. 11 "State of nuisance" means a condition in which a nuisance 12 (9)organism will foreseeably alter and threaten to harm the ecosystem or the abundance 13 14 and diversity of native or naturalized fish and other organisms. 15 (b) Except as provided under paragraph (2) of this subsection, the (1) 16 Secretary may adopt regulations to: 17 [prohibit] **PROHIBIT** the importation, possession, (I)introduction into State waters of a nonnative aquatic organism in order to prevent an 18 19 adverse impact on an aquatic ecosystem or the productivity of State waters; AND 20 REQUIRE (II)THE PURCHASE, SALE, TRANSPORT, 21IMPORTATION, POSSESSION, HARVEST, SEASON, SIZE LIMITS, OPEN AREA, 22CATCH DEVICES, AND INTRODUCTION OF NUISANCE ORGANISMS. The provisions of this section do not apply to: 23 (2)(i) An aquaculture operation for which the Department has issued a permit under Subtitle 11A of this title; or
