1 AN ACT concerning

Department of Natural Resources – Nonnative Nuisance and Naturalized
 Organisms – Regulatory Management Authority

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Secretary of the Department of Natural Resources to adopt regulations to manage certain nonnative nuisance or naturalized organisms in the State, subject to certain exceptions; <u>altering certain</u> <u>definitions</u>; and generally relating to nonnative nuisance organisms.

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 18 (2) "Aquatic organism" means an organism that lives part of its life in19 water.

1 (3) "Ecosystem" means a system of living organisms and their 2 environment, each influencing the life of the other and necessary for the maintenance 3 of life.

4 (4) "Introduction into State waters" includes use of an organism as 5 bait in the waters of the State.

6 (5) "Native" means having historically lived, grown, and reproduced in 7 State waters.

8 (6) "Naturalized" means documented as having lived, grown, and 9 reproduced in State waters for more than 10 years without known harm to the 10 ecosystem.

(7) "Nonnative" means other than native or naturalized.

(8) "Nuisance organism" means a nonnative OR NATURALIZED
 aquatic organism that will foreseeably alter and threaten to harm the ecosystem or the
 abundance and diversity of native or naturalized fish and other organisms.

(9) "State of nuisance" means a condition in which a nuisance
organism will foreseeably alter and threaten to harm the ecosystem or the abundance
and diversity of native or naturalized fish and other organisms.

18 (b) (1) Except as provided under paragraph (2) of this subsection, the
19 Secretary may adopt regulations to:

(I) [prohibit] **PROHIBIT** the importation, possession, or
 introduction into State waters of a nonnative aquatic organism in order to prevent an
 adverse impact on an aquatic ecosystem or the productivity of State waters; AND

(II) Require Manage The Sale, TRANSPORT, PURCHASE,
 IMPORTATION, POSSESSION, HARVEST, SEASON, SIZE LIMITS, OPEN AREA,
 CATCH DEVICES, AND INTRODUCTION OF NUISANCE ORGANISMS.

(2) The provisions of this section do not apply to:

27 (i) An aquaculture operation for which the Department has
 28 issued a permit under Subtitle 11A of this title; or

(ii) The possession, importation, or transport of a nonnative
 aquatic organism for purposes related to a permitted aquaculture operation; OR

31 (III) <u>A PERSON THAT HAS A VALID NURSERY INSPECTION</u> 32 <u>CERTIFICATE OR PLANT DEALER LICENSE ISSUED IN ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE</u> 33 **5, SUBTITLE 3 OF THE AGRICULTURE ARTICLE**.
