2 (h) (4) (i) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Board of 3 Trustees may create any position to the extent that the cost of the position, including 4 any fringe benefit costs, is funded from [grant or special project] **EXISTING** funds.

5 [(ii) The Board of Trustees shall abolish a position created under 6 this paragraph when the grant or special project funds are insufficient to fund the cost 7 of the position, including any fringe benefit costs.]

8 (II) 1. THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES MAY CREATE 9 POSITIONS THAT ARE FUNDED FROM GRANT OR SPECIAL PROJECT FUNDS, 10 INCLUDING ANY FRINGE BENEFIT COSTS.

112.THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL ABOLISH A12POSITION CREATED UNDER SUBSUBPARAGRAPH 1 OF THIS SUBPARAGRAPH13WHEN THE GRANT OR SPECIAL PROJECT FUNDS ARE INSUFFICIENT TO FUND14THE COST OF THE POSITION.
