13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 (f) "Forest game birds and mammals" means forest game birds (ruffed 18 grouse and turkey) and forest game mammals ([black bears,] deer, fox squirrels, 19 excluding the Delmarva subspecies, and gray and red squirrels) or any part, egg, 20 offspring, or dead body of any of them.

(A) [The] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION,
 THE Department may reduce the wildlife population in any county, election district, or
 other identifiable area of the State after a thorough investigation reveals that

protected wildlife is seriously injurious to agricultural or other interests in the affected area. The method of reducing the wildlife population is at the Department's discretion, except that trapping is preferred whenever feasible. The Department shall dispose of wildlife taken pursuant to the provisions of this section as the Department deems advisable.

6 (B) THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT REDUCE THE BLACK BEAR 7 POPULATION IN ANY AREA OF THE STATE EXCEPT:

8 (1) IN DEFENSE OF A PERSON, THE PROPERTY OF A PERSON, OR A 9 DOMESTICATED ANIMAL ON THE PROPERTY OF A PERSON; AND

10(2)**AFTER EXHAUSTING ALL NONLETHAL METHODS OF**11**RESOLVING CHRONIC DOCUMENTED AGRICULTURAL DAMAGE OR DEPREDATION**12**CAUSED BY THE BLACK BEAR.**

(a) (1) Pursuant to § 10–205 of this title, AND SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH
 (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, the Department shall establish by regulation and publish
 by July 1 each year the open season to hunt forest and upland game birds and
 mammals.

18(2)THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT ESTABLISH AN OPEN SEASON TO19HUNT BLACK BEARS.

20 [(2)] (3) Except as provided under § 10–410 of this subtitle, the 21 Department may not authorize hunting on a Sunday.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectOctober 1, 2008.
