17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 (a) To qualify for a license, an applicant shall be an individual who meets the
2 requirements of this section.

3 (b) The applicant shall be of good moral character.

4 (c) The applicant shall be at least [18] **21** years old.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
6 October 1, 2008.
