#### 1 AN ACT concerning

### 2 Employees' Retirement and Pension Systems – Purchase of Contractual 3 Service Credit

- 4 FOR the purpose of allowing certain members of the Employees' Retirement System or 5 Employees' Pension System to purchase a certain amount of service credit; 6 requiring certain members of the Employees' Retirement System or Employees' 7 Pension System who purchase certain service credit to file certain documents 8 with the Board of Trustees for the State Retirement and Pension System; 9 providing the rate at which certain service credit shall be purchased; providing 10 that certain service credit that certain members purchase is applied toward their retirement allowance using a certain accrual rate; and generally relating 11 to the purchase of service credit in the Employees' Retirement System or 12 Employees' Pension System. 13
