- 3 FOR the purpose of altering a provision of law to require the Secretary of Public Safety and Correctional Services to adopt regulations to govern the policies and 4 5 management of correctional facilities in the Department of Public Safety and 6 Correctional Services rather than the Division of Correction; requiring the 7 Secretary to adopt certain regulations establishing a certain minimum age for a 8 correctional officer hired on or after a certain date for employment in the Division of Pretrial Detention and Services or the Patuxent Institution, with a 9 certain exception; and generally relating to correctional facilities. 10

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 20 (a) The Secretary shall adopt regulations for the office of the Secretary.
- 21 (b) (1) The Secretary shall review regulations proposed by a unit in the 22 Department.

- 1 (2) The Secretary may approve, disapprove, or revise regulations 2 proposed by a unit in the Department.
- 3 (c) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, the 4 Secretary shall adopt regulations to govern the policies and management of correctional facilities in the [Division of Correction] **DEPARTMENT** in accordance with 6 Title 10, Subtitle 1 of the State Government Article.
- 7 (2) Paragraph (1) of this subsection does not apply to a guideline 8 pertaining to the routine internal management of correctional facilities in the Division 9 of Correction.
- 10 (3) (i) Subject to subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, the 11 Secretary shall adopt regulations that provide for a requirement that:
- 12 a correctional officer hired on or after October 1, 2007, for employment in any unit of the Division of Correction shall be at least 21 years old; AND
- 2. A CORRECTIONAL OFFICER HIRED ON OR AFTER
 OCTOBER 1, 2008, FOR EMPLOYMENT IN ANY UNIT OF THE DIVISION OF
 PRETRIAL DETENTION AND SERVICES OR THE PATUXENT INSTITUTION SHALL
 BE AT LEAST 21 YEARS OLD.
- 19 (ii) The regulations adopted under subparagraph (i) of this 20 paragraph shall exempt any honorably discharged veteran or reserve member of the 21 United States armed forces from the minimum age requirement.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008.
