- (b) The term of the one appointed member whose term is scheduled to expire on June 30, 2013, shall terminate at the end of June 30, 2014, and the member elected from Harford County at large at the general election in November 2013 shall succeed the appointed member and serve for a term of 4 years until a successor is elected and qualifies.
- (c) The terms of the two appointed members whose terms are scheduled to expire on June 30, 2014, and the term of the appointed member whose term is scheduled to expire on June 30, 2015, shall terminate at the end of June 30, 2014, and the members elected from councilmanic districts D, E, and F at the general election in November 2013 shall succeed those appointed members and serve for a term of 4 years until a successor is elected and qualifies.
- SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2008.
