## Governor's Office of Community Initiatives – Reorganization of Various State Entities

- 4 FOR the purpose of establishing statutorily the Governor's Office of Community 5 Initiatives; requiring the Governor's Office of Community Initiatives to include 6 certain units; transferring the Commission on Indian Affairs from the 7 Department of Human Resources to the Governor's Office of Community 8 Initiatives; transferring the Commission on African American History and 9 Culture from the Department of Planning to the Governor's Office of 10 Community Initiatives; providing for certain corrections in cross-references and terminology; altering the Division of Historical and Cultural Programs in the 11 12 Department of Planning; and generally relating to the Governor's Office of 13 Community Initiatives and the reorganization of various State entities.
