13 14	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 18 19 20 21 22 23	(e) (1) Subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection, in any action of summary ejectment for failure to pay rent where the landlord is awarded a judgment giving the landlord restitution of the leased premises, the tenant shall have the right to redemption of the leased premises by tendering in cash, certified check or money order to the landlord or the landlord's agent all past due amounts, as determined by the court under subsection (c) of this section, plus all court awarded costs and fees, at any time before actual execution of the eviction order.

2	RESIDENTIAL PURPOSES against whom 3 judgments of possession have been entered
3	for rent due and unpaid in the 12 months prior to the initiation of the action to which

- 5 (II) A TENANT OF LEASED PREMISES LEASED FOR BUSINESS, COMMERCIAL, MANUFACTURING, MERCANTILE, OR INDUSTRIAL PURPOSES OR ANY OTHER PURPOSE THAT IS NOT PRIMARILY RESIDENTIAL AGAINST WHOM A JUDGMENT OF POSSESSION HAS BEEN ENTERED FOR RENT DUE AND UNPAID IN THE 12 MONTHS PRIOR TO THE INITIATION OF THE ACTION TO WHICH THIS SUBSECTION OTHERWISE WOULD APPLY.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008.
