# A BILL ENTITLED

### 1 AN ACT concerning

### 2 Harford County Board of Education – Nomination and Appointment Process

FOR the purpose of specifying the membership of the Harford County Board of 3 4 Education; requiring the Governor to appoint a member of the County Board from a list of nominees submitted by the School Board Nominating Commission 5 6 of Harford County; requiring the Commission to solicit and select nominees to 7 the County Board and to hold certain public hearings before submitting its list 8 of nominees to the Governor; providing for the establishment, membership, 9 purpose, terms of office, and chair of the Commission; requiring the Commission to hold a certain meeting, adopt a charter containing certain provisions, and 10 11 take certain actions by certain dates; providing for a nonvoting student member of the County Board; and generally relating to the nomination and appointment 12process for the members of the Harford County Board of Education. 13

29	SHALL SUBMIT A LIST OF NOMINEES TO THE GOVERNOR FROM WHICH THE
30	GOVERNOR MAY MAKE AN APPOINTMENT TO FILL ANY VACANCY THAT EXISTS
31	OR THAT ARISES ON THE COUNTY BOARD.
32	(II) IN THE EVENT THAT THE LIST SUBMITTED TO THE
33	GOVERNOR UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH DOES NOT

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CONTAIN THE NAME OF A NOMINEE WHO IS QUALIFIED TO BE APPOINTED FOR A
 VACANCY, THE COMMISSION SHALL SUBMIT A LIST OF ADDITIONAL NOMINEES
 TO THE GOVERNOR NO LATER THAN 30 DAYS FOLLOWING THE VACANCY.

4 (III) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBPARAGRAPHS (I) AND (II) OF 5 THIS PARAGRAPH, THE COMMISSION SHALL SUBMIT A LIST OF NOMINEES TO 6 THE GOVERNOR FOR EACH OPEN SEAT ON THE COUNTY BOARD, WHETHER FOR 7 A MEMBER'S FIRST TERM, A MEMBER'S REAPPOINTMENT FOR A SECOND TERM, 8 OR FOR A VACANCY.

9 (IV) THE GOVERNOR SHALL MAKE AN APPOINTMENT TO 10 FILL A VACANCY ON THE COUNTY BOARD FROM THE LIST OF NOMINEES 11 SUBMITTED BY THE COMMISSION ON OR BEFORE THE **60**TH DAY AFTER 12 RECEIVING THE LIST.

13 (C) THE GOVERNOR:

(1) SHALL APPOINT A REGULAR MEMBER OF THE COUNTY
BOARD FROM A LIST OF NOMINEES SUBMITTED BY THE SCHOOL BOARD
NOMINATING COMMISSION OF HARFORD COUNTY AS PROVIDED IN
SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.

(2) THE GOVERNOR MAY NOT APPOINT ANY OTHER INDIVIDUAL
 TO THE COUNTY BOARD OR OTHERWISE CIRCUMVENT THE NOMINATIONS OF
 THE SCHOOL BOARD NOMINATING COMMISSION OF HARFORD COUNTY THAT
 ARE SUBMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR BY THE COMMISSION.

(3) IF THE GOVERNOR REJECTS EACH OF THE NOMINEES ON THE
LIST SUBMITTED BY THE COMMISSION FOR A VACANCY ON THE COUNTY BOARD,
THE COMMISSION SHALL SUBMIT ANOTHER LIST OF NOMINEES TO THE
GOVERNOR. THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT A NOMINEE FROM ONE OF THE
LISTS SUBMITTED BY THE COMMISSION.

27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect28 July 1, 2008.
