#### 1 AN ACT concerning

#### 2 Nursing Facilities – Accountability Measures – Pay–for–Performance

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to 4 develop a plan for accountability measures to use in a pay-for-performance 5 program; delaying a requirement that certain revenues be distributed to certain 6 nursing facilities subject to a certain Act; requiring that the plan for 7 accountability measures include certain items; requiring the Department to 8 submit the plan for accountability measures to the General Assembly by a 9 certain date: and generally relating to nursing facilities and 10 pay-for-performance.

- 12 Chapter 503 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 200713 Section 5
- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

#### Chapter 503 of the Acts of 2007

- 17 SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That it is the intent of the 18 General Assembly that:
- 19 (a) Beginning July 1, <del>2009</del> [2008] **2009**, a portion of the revenues from the 20 quality assessment shall be distributed to nursing facilities subject to this Act based

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on accountability measures that indicate quality of care or a commitment to quality of 1  $\mathbf{2}$ care. THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE SHALL DEVELOP A 3 PLAN FOR ACCOUNTABILITY MEASURES TO USE IN A PAY-FOR-PERFORMANCE 4 PROGRAM IN CONSULTATION WITH REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NURSING  $\mathbf{5}$ FACILITIES AND OTHER STAKEHOLDERS. The accountability measures should be 6 objective, measurable, and when considered in combination with each other, deemed to 7 have a correlation to residents' quality of life and care. [The Department of Health and Mental Hygiene shall develop accountability measures in consultation with 8 9 representatives of the nursing facilities and other stakeholders.]

19 [(b)] (C) Up to 25% of the revenues generated by the quality assessment 20 shall be IN AN INCENTIVE PROGRAM TO BE distributed as provided in this section, to 21 the extent federal law allows. Further, the distribution of revenues as provided in this 22 section shall be used as an incentive for nursing facilities to provide quality care, and 23 may not be used to directly or indirectly hold harmless any nursing facility.

(D) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2008, THE PLAN REQUIRED UNDER
THIS SECTION SHALL BE SUBMITTED BY THE DEPARTMENT, IN ACCORDANCE
WITH § 2–1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO THE GENERAL
ASSEMBLY.
