BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments, Article - Natural Resources Section 10-410(a)(1)Annotated Code of Maryland (2007 Replacement Volume) BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Natural Resources Section 10-410(a)(2)Annotated Code of Maryland (2007 Replacement Volume) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article - Natural Resources** 10–410.

$\frac{3}{4}$	(2) The following persons may hunt the specified game birds and mammals on Sundays:
5 6	(i) A person using State certified raptors to hunt game birds or mammals during open season;
7 8	(ii) An unarmed person participating in an organized fox chase to chase foxes;
9 10	(iii) Provided that the provisions of $\ 10-906(b)(3)$ of this title are met, a person:
11 12	1. Using a regulated shooting ground under § 10–906 of this title to hunt the following pen–reared game birds:

23 24 25 26	(iv) Subject to the provisions of § 10–411 of this subtitle, in Dorchester, St. Mary's, Somerset, WASHINGTON , Wicomico, and Worcester counties, a person hunting deer on private property with a bow and arrow during open season on the last three Sundays in October and the second Sunday in November.
