## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2005 - Baltimore City - Project**  
3 **T.O.O.U.R.**

4 FOR the purpose of amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2005  
5 to extend the deadline by which the Board of Directors of Project T.O.O.U.R.,  
6 Inc. may present evidence to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund  
7 will be provided.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
9 Chapter 445 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2005  
10 Section 1(3) Item ZA01(U)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Chapter 445 of the Acts of 2005**

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
15 MARYLAND, That:

16 (3) ZA01 LOCAL HOUSE OF DELEGATES INITIATIVES

17 (U) Project T.O.O.U.R. Provide a grant equal to the lesser of (i)  
18 \$100,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided, to  
19 the Board of Directors of Project T.O.O.U.R., Inc. for the  
20 planning, design, repair, renovation, reconstruction, and  
21 capital equipping of two adjacent buildings that will serve as  
22 a neighborhood service center providing community  
23 assistance programs, located in Baltimore City.  
24 Notwithstanding Section 1(5) of this Act, the matching fund  
25 may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds
