A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Legislative Community Initiatives Loan of 2004 – Montgomery County –**
3 **Kensington Recreation Center**

4 FOR the purpose of amending the Legislative Community Initiatives Loan of 2004 to
5 alter the authorized uses of the grant and to extend the date by which the
6 County Executive and County Council of Montgomery County must present
7 evidence that a matching fund will be provided.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
9 Chapter 204 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2003, as amended by
10 Chapter 432 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2004, and Chapter
11 608 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2006

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Chapter 204 of the Acts of 2003, as amended by Chapter 432 of the Acts of**
16 **2004 and Chapter 608 of the Acts of 2006**

17 SECTION 13. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

18 (3) (i) \$15,200,000 for the following projects initially approved by the
19 Senate:

20 (AM) [Kensington Recreation Center.] **WARNER MANOR.** Provide
21 a grant equal to the lesser of (i) \$100,000 or (ii) the amount of
22 the matching fund provided, to the County Executive and
23 County Council of Montgomery County for the [acquisition,]
24 planning, [and] design, **RENOVATION, AND DEMOLITION** of
25 the [Kensington Recreation Center,] **WARNER MANOR,**
