17	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18	MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21	(a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.



- 1 (b) "Approach" means any roadway, overhead structure, ramp, bridge, causeway, entrance, and exit provided as a means of access to or departure from a vehicular crossing.
- 4 (c) "Bridge" means any bridge within the jurisdiction of the Maryland 5 Transportation Authority.
- 6 (d) "Tunnel" means:
- 7 (1) The Baltimore Harbor Tunnel; and
- 8 (2) Any other tunnel within the jurisdiction of the Maryland 9 Transportation Authority.
- 10 (e) "Vehicular crossing" means:
- 11 (1) Each tunnel and bridge within the jurisdiction of the Maryland 12 Transportation Authority; and
- 13 (2) Each approach to these tunnels and bridges.

- 15 (a) [Pedestrians] UNLESS AUTHORIZED BY THE CHAIRMAN OF THE 16 MARYLAND TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY, PEDESTRIANS may not use any vehicular crossing.
- 18 (b) [Bicycles] UNLESS AUTHORIZED BY THE CHAIRMAN OF THE 19 MARYLAND TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY, BICYCLES may not use any vehicular 20 crossing.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008.
