## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicular Crossings – Use by Pedestrians and Bicycles – Authorization**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the use of certain vehicular crossings under the  
4 jurisdiction of the Maryland Transportation Authority by pedestrians and  
5 bicycles when authorized by the Chairman of the Maryland Transportation  
6 Authority; and generally relating to the use of vehicular crossings.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Transportation**

20 21–1401.

21 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

1 (b) "Approach" means any roadway, overhead structure, ramp, bridge,  
2 causeway, entrance, and exit provided as a means of access to or departure from a  
3 vehicular crossing.

4 (c) "Bridge" means any bridge within the jurisdiction of the Maryland  
5 Transportation Authority.

6 (d) "Tunnel" means:

7 (1) The Baltimore Harbor Tunnel; and

8 (2) Any other tunnel within the jurisdiction of the Maryland  
9 Transportation Authority.

10 (e) "Vehicular crossing" means:

11 (1) Each tunnel and bridge within the jurisdiction of the Maryland  
12 Transportation Authority; and

13 (2) Each approach to these tunnels and bridges.

14 21-1405.

15 (a) [Pedestrians] **UNLESS AUTHORIZED BY THE CHAIRMAN OF THE**  
16 **MARYLAND TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY, PEDESTRIANS** may not use any  
17 vehicular crossing.

18 (b) [Bicycles] **UNLESS AUTHORIZED BY THE CHAIRMAN OF THE**  
19 **MARYLAND TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY, BICYCLES** may not use any vehicular  
20 crossing.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
22 October 1, 2008.
