2 **Montgomery County – Oakmont Special Taxing Area – Competitive Bidding**

3 **MC 820-08**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the threshold amount above which the Oakmont Citizens'
5 Committee is required to advertise for bids for the purchase of materials or
6 contract for work; providing for an exception to advertising for competitive bids
7 under certain circumstances; making certain stylistic changes; and generally
8 relating to competitive bidding by the Oakmont Citizens' Committee.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article 16 – Montgomery County**

18 The Oakmont Citizens' Committee [shall] **MAY** not expend for material or work
19 a sum exceeding [two] **TEN** thousand dollars [(\$2,000.00)] **(\$10,000)** without having

1 first advertised the specifications [therefor] and inviting bids for the same, after which
 2 the committee may purchase such material [or may], contract for [such] **THE** work, or
 3 have [such] **THE** work done by employed labor, or otherwise as it may deem best[; and
 4 provided further, that the committee may make contracts, and provided further, that
 5 no member of the citizens' committee shall]. **PROVIDED FURTHER THAT THE**
 6 **CITIZENS' COMMITTEE MAY, BY UNANIMOUS VOTE, ENTER INTO A CONTRACT**
 7 **EXCEEDING \$10,000 WITHOUT SEEKING COMPETITIVE BIDS IF THE CONTRACT**
 8 **IS NECESSARY TO MEET AN URGENT NEED. NO MEMBER OF THE CITIZENS'**
 9 **COMMITTEE MAY** furnish any supplies of any kind or contract in any manner with the
 10 citizens' committee.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 12 October 1, 2008.
