2 (B) A QUALIFYING FOSTER PARENT MAY ENROLL AND PARTICIPATE IN 3 THE HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFIT OPTIONS ESTABLISHED UNDER THE 4 PROGRAM AND RECEIVE THE SAME STATE SUBSIDY PROVIDED TO STATE 5 EMPLOYEES.
