A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Baltimore County – Board of Education – Appointment Process

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor to appoint a member of the Baltimore 4 County Board of Education from a list of nominees submitted by the School 5 Board Nominating Commission of Baltimore County; requiring the Commission 6 to hold certain public hearings before recommending to the Governor nominees 7 for appointment to the County Board; providing for the establishment, purpose, membership, terms of office, and chair of the Commission; requiring the 8 9 Commission to submit to the Governor a certain list of nominees for each 10 nomination to the County Board beginning on a certain date; authorizing 11 members of the County Board to serve the remainder of a member's first term or a second consecutive term; specifying the process of reappointment of 12 members serving on the County Board as of a certain date; altering the regions 13 14 from which members of the County Board are appointed; providing for the 15appointment of members to the County Board; and generally relating to the 16 Baltimore County Board of Education.

- 22 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 23 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21**(II)** THE PURPOSE OF THE COMMISSION IS TO SELECT 22NOMINEES TO BE RECOMMENDED TO THE GOVERNOR AS QUALIFIED 23CANDIDATES FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE BALTIMORE COUNTY BOARD OF 24EDUCATION.

25THE COMMISSION SHALL HOLD AT LEAST THREE (III) 26PUBLIC MEETINGS ON THE SELECTION OF NOMINEES BEFORE RECOMMENDING 27TO THE GOVERNOR NOMINEES FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE COUNTY BOARD.

THE BALTIMORE COUNTY LEAGUE OF WOMEN 15VOTERS. 16 **(V)** AN APPOINTMENT UNDER SUBPARAGRAPHS (II) AND 17 (III) OF THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL BE MADE WITH CONSIDERATION OF THE 18 GEOGRAPHIC, RACIAL, ETHNIC, CULTURAL, AND GENDER DIVERSITY OF THE 19 **COMMISSION.** 20 (3) THE GOVERNOR SHALL DESIGNATE AS CHAIR OF THE **(I)** 21COMMISSION ONE OF THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION. 22THE TERM OF THE CHAIR OF THE COMMISSION IS 2 **(II)** 23YEARS. 24(III) THE GOVERNOR MAY REAPPOINT THE CHAIR OF THE 25**COMMISSION FOR A SECOND TERM.** 26 (IV) THE TERM OF A MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION 27APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR OR THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE IS 4 YEARS. 28**(V)** THE TERM OF A MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION 29 APPOINTED BY AN ORGANIZATION UNDER PARAGRAPH (2)(IV) OF THIS 30 SUBSECTION SHALL BE DETERMINED BY THE APPOINTING ORGANIZATION.

1 (4) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2009, FOR EACH NOMINATION TO 2 THE COUNTY BOARD, THE COMMISSION SHALL SUBMIT TO THE GOVERNOR A 3 LIST OF NOMINEES THAT CONTAINS:

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(I) NO MORE THAN THREE NAMES FOR EACH VACANCY; OR

5 (II) IF THERE ARE FEWER THAN THREE APPLICANTS FOR A 6 VACANCY, THE NUMBER OF NAMES THAT IS EQUAL TO THE NUMBER OF 7 APPLICANTS FOR THE VACANCY.

8 (5) IF THE GOVERNOR REJECTS ALL OF THE NOMINEES FOR A 9 VACANCY SUBMITTED BY THE SCHOOL BOARD NOMINATING COMMISSION IN 10 ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH (4) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE COMMISSION 11 SHALL SUBMIT TO THE GOVERNOR THREE ADDITIONAL NAMES FOR EACH 12 VACANCY, OR IF THERE ARE FEWER THAT THREE APPLICANTS FOR A VACANCY, 13 THE NUMBER OF NAMES THAT IS EQUAL TO THE NUMBER OF APPLICANTS FOR 14 THE VACANCY.

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the term of the appointed member from councilmanic district 5, set to expire on June30, 2008;

3 (b) The Governor shall appoint a member to the Baltimore County Board 4 from the Northwest administrative area of the Baltimore County public school system 5 to the vacancy on the Baltimore County Board resulting from the expiration of the 6 term of the appointed member from councilmanic district 2, set to expire on June 30, 7 2009;

32 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That a member serving a first 33 term on the Baltimore County Board of Education on or before June 30, 2009:

(a) (1) shall be eligible to be included in the list of nominees submitted by
the School Board Nominating Commission of Baltimore County to the Governor to
serve a second term when the first term ends; and

37 (2) may be reappointed by the Governor; and

1 (b) as provided in 3-108(c)(3) of the Education Article, is not eligible to 2 serve another consecutive term following the second term by a reappointment.

3 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 4 July 1, 2008.
