## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Carroll County – Board of Education – Compensation**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the compensation of the Chairman and the other  
4 members of the Board of Education of Carroll County; providing that this Act  
5 does not apply to the salary or compensation of the incumbent Chairman and  
6 other members of the Board of Education of Carroll County; and generally  
7 relating to the Board of Education of Carroll County.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
9 Article – Education  
10 Section 3–403  
11 Annotated Code of Maryland  
12 (2006 Replacement Volume and 2007 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Education**

16 3–403.

17 (a) The Chairman of the County Board is entitled to receive [~~\$6,000~~] **\$7,500**  
18 annually as compensation and the other members are entitled to receive [~~\$5,000~~]  
19 **\$6,500** each annually as compensation.

20 (b) The compensation of the Chairman and the members described in  
21 subsection (a) of this section shall be paid in four equal quarterly installments.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, §  
23 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to  
24 the salary or compensation of the Chairman of the Board of Education of Carroll

1 County or the members of the Board of Education of Carroll County in office on the  
2 effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or  
3 compensation of the Chairman of the Board of Education of Carroll County and the  
4 members of the Board of Education of Carroll County shall take effect at the beginning  
5 of the next following term of office.

6 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
7 July 1, 2008.
