- 16 (a) The Comptroller shall set the number and compensation of assistant clerks or deputies employed by each register of wills.
- 18 (B) NONELECTED EMPLOYEES IN POSITIONS IN THE OFFICES OF THE 19 REGISTERS OF WILLS ARE IN THE SKILLED SERVICE, THE PROFESSIONAL 20 SERVICE, OR THE MANAGEMENT SERVICE IN THE STATE PERSONNEL 21 MANAGEMENT SYSTEM.
- [(b)] (C) Compensation from an account for services of an assistant clerk, deputy, or other individual who performs any of the duties pertaining to the office of a register of wills may not be allowed until the individual certifies under oath that:



1	(1) the services have been performed;
