 to required security for vehicles.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 15 Article Transportation
- 16 17–106.

17 (a) If the required security for any vehicle [terminates or otherwise] lapses18 at any time, the registration of that vehicle:

- 19(1) Is suspended automatically as of the date of [termination or] THE20lapse EFFECTIVE NOT LATER THAN 60 DAYS AFTER NOTIFICATION TO THE21ADMINISTRATION THAT THE LAPSE HAS OCCURRED; and

1 (i) The required security is replaced and the vehicle owner 2 submits evidence of replaced security on a form as prescribed by the Administration 3 and certified by an insurer or insurance producer; and

4 (ii) Any uninsured motorist penalty fee assessed is paid to the 5 Administration.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2008.
