## HOUSE BILL 985

1 (a) (1) In this subsection, "Energy Star product" means an air conditioner, 2 clothes washer or dryer, furnace, heat pump, standard size refrigerator, compact 3 fluorescent light bulb, dehumidifier, **BOILER**, or programmable thermostat that has 4 been designated as meeting or exceeding the applicable Energy Star efficiency 5 requirements developed by the United States Environmental Protection Agency and 6 the United States Department of Energy.

7 (2) Beginning in calendar year 2011, the weekend that consists of the 8 Saturday immediately preceding the third Monday in February through the third 9 Monday in February each year shall be a tax-free weekend during which the 10 exemption under paragraph (3) of this subsection shall apply.

11 (3) During the tax-free weekend established under paragraph (2) of 12 this subsection, the sales and use tax does not apply to the sale of any:

- 13 (i) Energy Star product; or
- 14 (ii) solar water heater.

(b) The sales and use tax does not apply to the sale of a multifuel pellet stovedesigned to burn agricultural field corn.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectJuly 1, 2008.
