 TIME AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE, THE EMPLOYEE MAY NOT RECEIVE SERVICE
 CREDIT FOR EMPLOYMENT WITH THE TOWN OF BERWYN HEIGHTS BEFORE THE
 EFFECTIVE DATE.
