(2) "BROADBAND PROVIDER" MEANS A PERSON WHO SELLS OR OTHERWISE PROVIDES BROADBAND SERVICE TO CUSTOMERS.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 2008.
