## 10 Article - State Finance and Procurement

- 12 (a) This section does not apply to:
- 13 (1) property that is pledged to secure the payment of principal of or 14 interest on revenue bonds; or
- 15 (2) real property that is owned or controlled by the State Highway 16 Administration.
- 17 (b) (1) The Board may transfer any property, and all rights of physical custody and control over the property, from a unit of the Executive Branch of the State government to another unit of the Executive Branch of the State government.
- 20 (2) Any property transferred under this subsection is subject to the 21 continuing general jurisdiction of the Board.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008.
