## A BILL ENTITLED

### **Charitable Solicitations – Commercial Resellers**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from acting as a commercial reseller unless 4 the person has applied to register with the Secretary of State; requiring an 5 applicant for registration as a commercial reseller to submit a certain 6 application to the Secretary of State; requiring an applicant for registration as a 7 commercial reseller to consent to the jurisdiction and venue of a certain court in 8 certain actions; requiring an applicant for registration as a commercial reseller 9 to pay a certain application fee; requiring an applicant for registration as a 10 commercial reseller to make certain certifications; requiring the Secretary of 11 State to approve certain applications under certain circumstances; requiring the Secretary of State to give certain notice to certain applicants; providing for the 12 expiration of a commercial reseller registration; requiring a commercial reseller 13 14 to submit to the Secretary of State a certain annual financial report at a certain 15time; requiring a commercial reseller to display a certain notice at certain 16 locations in the commercial reseller's place of business; and generally relating to 17the regulation of commercial resellers.

  SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

27 SUBTITLE 5B. COMMERCIAL RESELLERS.

1 **6–5B–01.** 

(A) IN THIS SUBTITLE, "COMMERCIAL RESELLER" MEANS A PERSON
 THAT, FOR PROFIT, OFFERS FOR SALE TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC USED
 PERSONAL PROPERTY, INCLUDING HOUSEHOLD GOODS, FURNITURE,
 APPLIANCES, OR CLOTHING IF:

6 (1) THE PERSON OBTAINS A MAJORITY OF ITS INVENTORY BY THE
7 PURCHASE, RECEIPT, OR CONTROL FOR RESALE OF USED PERSONAL PROPERTY
8 SOLICITED BY OR ON BEHALF OF A CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION; AND

9 (2) THE NAME OF A CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION IS USED 10 EXPRESSLY OR IMPLICITLY TO INDUCE THE PURCHASE OF THE USED PERSONAL 11 PROPERTY.

12 (B) "COMMERCIAL RESELLER" DOES NOT INCLUDE A CHARITABLE 13 ORGANIZATION.

A PERSON IS PROHIBITED FROM ACTING AS A COMMERCIAL RESELLER
 UNLESS THE PERSON HAS APPLIED TO REGISTER WITH THE SECRETARY OF
 STATE.

18 **6–5B–03.** 

19 AN APPLICANT FOR REGISTRATION AS A COMMERCIAL RESELLER SHALL:

20 (1) SUBMIT TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE AN APPLICATION 21 UNDER OATH ON THE FORM THE SECRETARY OF STATE PROVIDES;

(2) CONSENT IN WRITING TO THE JURISDICTION AND VENUE OF
 THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY IN ACTIONS BROUGHT
 UNDER THIS TITLE;

25 (3) PAY TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE AN APPLICATION FEE OF
 26 \$100 FOR REGISTRATION AS A COMMERCIAL RESELLER;

(4) (I) CERTIFY THAT ALL TAXES DUE FROM THE APPLICANT
TO THE STATE OR A COUNTY DURING THE PRECEDING FISCAL YEAR HAVE BEEN
PAID, AND ALL TAXES THE APPLICANT WAS REQUIRED TO COLLECT AND PAY
OVER TO THE STATE OR A COUNTY DURING THE PRECEDING FISCAL YEAR HAVE
BEEN COLLECTED AND PAID OVER; OR

1 (II) CERTIFY THAT THE TAXES DUE FROM THE APPLICANT 2 TO THE STATE OR A COUNTY ARE UNDER DISPUTE AND THE DISPUTE HAS NOT 3 BEEN FINALLY RESOLVED; AND

4 (5) PROVIDE ANY OTHER NONPROPRIETARY INFORMATION THAT 5 THE SECRETARY OF STATE REQUIRES BY REGULATION.

6 **6–5B–04.** 

7 (A) IF THE SECRETARY OF STATE FINDS THAT AN APPLICANT FOR 8 REGISTRATION HAS COMPLIED WITH THIS SUBTITLE AND THE REGULATIONS 9 ADOPTED UNDER IT, THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL APPROVE THE 10 APPLICATION.

11 (B) IF THE SECRETARY OF STATE FINDS THAT AN APPLICANT FOR 12 REGISTRATION HAS NOT COMPLIED WITH THIS SUBTITLE AND THE 13 REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER IT APPLICABLE TO REGISTRATION, THE 14 SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL NOTIFY THE APPLICANT OF THE REASONS THE 15 APPLICANT IS NOT IN COMPLIANCE.

17 EACH REGISTRATION EXPIRES ON THE FIRST ANNIVERSARY OF ITS 18 APPROVAL DATE.

20(A) A COMMERCIAL RESELLER SHALL SUBMIT AN ANNUAL FINANCIAL21REPORT TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE:

22(1) WITHIN 6 MONTHS AFTER THE END OF THE COMMERCIAL23RESELLER'S FISCAL YEAR; OR

(2) BY ANY LATER DATE THAT THE SECRETARY OF STATE SETS.

25 (B) THE ANNUAL FINANCIAL REPORT SHALL CONTAIN:
