21	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- (a) Except for the occupant of a disabled vehicle who seeks the aid of another vehicle, a person may not stand in a roadway to solicit a ride, employment, or business from the occupant of any vehicle.
- 4 (b) A person may not stand on or near a highway to solicit any other person to watch or guard any vehicle while it is parked or about to be parked on a highway.
- 6 (c) In Carroll County, Charles County, Frederick County, Harford County, 7 and Washington County, a person may not stand in a roadway, median divider, or intersection to solicit money or donations of any kind from the occupant of a vehicle.
  - (d) (1) [In Prince George's County:
- 10 (i) A child under the age of 15 years may not stand in a 11 roadway, median divider, or intersection to solicit money or donations of any kind from 12 the occupant of a vehicle; and] **THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES TO PRINCE GEORGE'S** 13 **COUNTY.**
- 14 (2) (I) A PERSON MAY NOT STAND IN A HIGHWAY TO:
- 15 SOLICIT MONEY OR DONATIONS OF ANY KIND 16 FROM THE OCCUPANT OF A VEHICLE; OR
- 17 **2.** ADVERTISE ANY MESSAGE.
- 18 (ii) An adult may not cause, encourage, allow, or petition a child 19 under the age of 15 years to [stand in a roadway, median divider, or intersection to 20 solicit money or donations of any kind from the occupant of a vehicle] **VIOLATE** 21 **SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH**.
  - (III) IN THIS PARAGRAPH, "HIGHWAY" INCLUDES:

RIGHTS-OF-WAY, ROADWAY SURFACES, ROADWAY 24SUBGRADES, SHOULDERS, MEDIAN DIVIDERS, DRAINAGE FACILITIES AND 25 STRUCTURES, RELATED STORMWATER MANAGEMENT **FACILITIES** AND 26 STRUCTURES, ROADWAY CUTS, ROADWAY FILLS, GUARDRAILS, BRIDGES, 27 HIGHWAY GRADE SEPARATION STRUCTURES, RAILROAD GRADE SEPARATIONS, 28 TUNNELS, OVERPASSES, UNDERPASSES, INTERCHANGES, ENTRANCE PLAZAS, 29 APPROACHES, AND OTHER STRUCTURES FORMING AN INTEGRAL PART OF A 30 STREET, ROAD, OR HIGHWAY, INCLUDING BICYCLE AND WALKING PATHS; AND
- 2. Any other property acquired for the construction, operation, or use of the highway.

  (ii) If the County Commissioners or the governing body of a municipal corporation in the county enact a resolution or ordinance establishing a permit program authorized by this paragraph, the resolution or ordinance shall:

  1. Require an applicant for a permit to submit proof that
- the individual or qualified organization has a plan for safely soliciting money or donations from the proposed location;
- 9 2. Provide that a permit is effective for a period of 1 10 calendar day; and
- 3. Allow an individual or a qualified organization to obtain only one permit per calendar year.
  - (g) (1) In Montgomery County, a child under the age of 18 years may not stand in a roadway, median divider, or intersection to solicit money or donations of any kind from the occupant of a vehicle.
- 16 (2) This subsection shall be enforced by the issuance of a warning that 17 informs the offender of the requirements of this subsection.
  - SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That if any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid for any reason in a court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or any other application of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and for this purpose the provisions of this Act are declared severable.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008.
