16	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17	MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(b) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, every new application for a
license shall be made to the Board of License Commissioners [upon] ON forms
prescribed by the Comptroller and sworn to by the applicant. Every application for a
license shall contain the following statements:

1 (3) Except in Baltimore, [and] Howard, AND PRINCE GEORGE'S 2 counties, a statement that the applicant is a citizen of the United States;

3 (6) Except in Baltimore, [and] Howard, AND PRINCE GEORGE'S 4 counties, the place of birth of the applicant, and if a naturalized citizen, when and 5 where [he] THE APPLICANT was naturalized;

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 July 1, 2008.
