 to a special fund to be used by the Maryland State Department of Education for
 certain purposes; and generally relating to Maryland Correctional Enterprises.

- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Correctional Services

15 3–507.

16 (a) The Department shall include the budget for Maryland Correctional
 17 Enterprises in the Department's budget.

18 (b) (1) Maryland Correctional Enterprises may establish a revolving fund
 19 to contain an amount that the Treasurer approves.

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1 [(2) (i) For each of fiscal years 2006 through 2009, the first 2 \$1,000,000 in the revolving fund in excess of the amount required to operate Maryland 3 Correctional Enterprises shall be transferred to a special fund to be used by the State 4 Department of Education for the operation of educational programs in correctional 5 institutions.

6 (ii) Money from the revolving fund shall supplement and may 7 not supplant funding for the operation of educational programs in correctional 8 institutions.]

9 [(3)] (2) (i) Subject to the provisions of subparagraph (ii) of this 10 paragraph, the revolving fund may be used for general operating expenses and the 11 purchase of capital assets.

12 (ii) The revolving fund may be used to provide financial 13 assistance, up to \$250,000 in a fiscal year, to the Division of Correction to establish 14 and operate employment readiness training programs and transitional services to 15 rehabilitate inmates currently or previously employed by Maryland Correctional 16 Enterprises.

17 [(4)] (3) The revolving fund established under paragraph (1) of this
18 subsection is not subject to § 7–302 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

19 [(5)] (4) Maryland Correctional Enterprises shall submit an annual 20 statement to the Comptroller and the Treasurer that provides an accurate and 21 detailed accounting of all receipts and disbursements from the revolving fund.

(c) General Fund money may be appropriated to Maryland Correctional
 Enterprises to be used for the direct expenses of training inmates.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 25 July 1, 2008.
