A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Higher Education – College Textbooks – Disclosures and Sales

3 FOR the purpose of requiring a certain publisher of college textbooks to disclose 4 certain information about certain textbooks to prospective purchasers; 5 prohibiting the price of certain textbooks from being changed during a certain period of time; requiring the governing body of public institutions of higher 6 education in the State to adopt certain procedures regarding the sale of certain 7 8 textbooks to certain students and requiring certain stores to sell certain 9 textbooks to certain students in accordance with certain procedures; and 10 generally relating to the disclosure of information by publishers of college textbooks and sales of textbooks. 11

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- (A) (1) EACH PUBLISHER OF COLLEGE TEXTBOOKS THAT OFFERS
 TEXTBOOKS FOR SALE AT A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE
 STATE SHALL DISCLOSE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION ABOUT EACH
 TEXTBOOK TO A PROSPECTIVE PURCHASER:

1 (I) THE RETAIL PRICE A STUDENT WILL PAY FOR THE 2 TEXTBOOK IN THE BOOKSTORE;

3 (II) THE PUBLICATION DATE OF EACH PREVIOUS EDITION
 4 OF THE TEXTBOOK, IF ANY; AND

5 (III) THE AVAILABILITY OF LOWER-PRICED VERSIONS OR
6 ALTERNATIVES, INCLUDING UNBUNDLED OR ON-LINE VERSIONS OF THE
7 TEXTBOOK, IF ANY.

8 (2) THE PRICE OF A TEXTBOOK QUOTED TO A BOOKSTORE BY A 9 PUBLISHER UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION MAY NOT BE 10 CHANGED DURING THE ACADEMIC TERM FOR WHICH THE TEXTBOOK IS 11 REQUIRED FOR COURSES OFFERED AT THE INSTITUTION.

12 (B) THE GOVERNING BODY OF EACH PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER 13 EDUCATION IN THE STATE SHALL:

14 (1) ADOPT PROCEDURES THAT WOULD ALLOW A STUDENT WHO
15 HAS BEEN AWARDED FINANCIAL AID THAT HAS NOT BEEN DISBURSED TO THE
16 STUDENT AS OF THE START OF THE ACADEMIC TERM TO PURCHASE, DURING
17 THE FIRST WEEK OF THE ACADEMIC TERM, TEXTBOOKS REQUIRED FOR
18 COURSES OFFERED AT THE INSTITUTION AND TO PAY FOR THE TEXTBOOKS AT A
19 LATER DATE UPON DISBURSAL OF THE STUDENT'S FINANCIAL AID AWARD; AND

(2) REQUIRE ANY STORE THAT SELLS TEXTBOOKS REQUIRED FOR
 COURSES OFFERED AT THE INSTITUTION THAT IS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF
 THE INSTITUTION TO SELL TEXTBOOKS TO STUDENTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH
 THE PROCEDURES ADOPTED UNDER ITEM (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 25 July 1, 2008.

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
