12 13	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 17	(a) In this section, "dually enrolled student" means a student who is dually enrolled in:
18	(1) (I) A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE secondary school in the State; OR
19 20 21 22	(II) A PROGRAM OF INSTRUCTION IN WHICH THE STUDENT RECEIVES REGULAR, THOROUGH INSTRUCTION DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR IN THE STUDIES USUALLY TAUGHT IN THE PUBLIC SECONDARY SCHOOLS TO STUDENTS OF THE SAME AGE; and
23	(2) An institution of higher education in the State.



1 2 3	(b) In cooperation with institutions of higher education in the State, the Commission shall establish and administer a grant program for dually enrolled students.
4	(c) A recipient of a dual enrollment grant shall:
5	(1) Be a resident of the State;
6	(2) Be a dually enrolled student; and
7 8	(3) Demonstrate financial need according to criteria established by the Commission.
9 10 11	(d) For courses completed under the program, a recipient of a dual enrollment grant is not required to receive credit from a secondary school and an institution of higher education at the same time.
12 13	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2008.
