1 AN ACT concerning

### 2 Polysomnographic Technologists – Education Requirements – Waiver

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Board of Physicians to waive certain education 4 requirements for certain polysomnographic technologists who have practiced polysomnography in another state and meet certain requirements; 5 and 6 generally relating to the waiver of education requirements for 7 polysomnographic technologists.

## 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 21 14–5C–01.
- 22 (b) "Board" means the State Board of Physicians.

 $\mathbf{2}$ HOUSE BILL 1082 1 The Board shall waive the education requirement under § 14-5C-09(c)(3)(a)  $\mathbf{2}$ of this subtitle if on or before September 30, 2009, an individual: 3 (1)Has passed the national certifying examination by the Board of 4 Registered Polysomnographic Technologists; Is certified by the Board of Registered Polysomnographic 5 (2)Technologists as a registered polysomnographic technologist; 6 7 (3)Has submitted an application for licensure to the Board; and 8 (4)Meets all of the requirements under § 14-5C-09(b) and (c)(1) and 9 (2) of this subtitle. 10 **(B)** IF AN INDIVIDUAL HAS PRACTICED POLYSOMNOGRAPHY IN 11 ANOTHER STATE, THE BOARD SHALL WAIVE THE EDUCATION REQUIREMENT 12UNDER § 14–5C–09(C)(3) OF THIS SUBTITLE IF ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 30, 13**2014, THE INDIVIDUAL:** 14 HAS PASSED THE NATIONAL CERTIFYING EXAMINATION BY (1) 15THE BOARD OF REGISTERED POLYSOMNOGRAPHIC TECHNOLOGISTS; 16 (2) Is CERTIFIED BY THE BOARD OF REGISTERED 17**POLYSOMNOGRAPHIC TECHNOLOGISTS AS A REGISTERED POLYSOMNOGRAPHIC** 18 **TECHNOLOGIST:** 19 (3) HAS SUBMITTED AN APPLICATION FOR LICENSURE TO THE 20**BOARD; AND** 21(4) MEETS ALL OF THE REQUIREMENTS UNDER § 14-5C-09(B) 22AND (C)(1) AND (2) OF THIS SUBTITLE. 23(b) (C) If an individual has not satisfied the requirements under (1)24subsection (a) of this section on or before September 30, 2009, OR THE 25**REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION ON OR BEFORE** 26**SEPTEMBER 30, 2014,** the individual may petition the Board for an extension.
