regulations; and generally relating to the maintenance of sidewalks in

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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Article 22 – Washington County

(a) The County Commissioners, in addition to but not in substitution of the
 powers which have been or may be granted them, may require the installation AND
 MAINTENANCE of sidewalks along the public streets and highways of the county,
 except in incorporated municipalities of the county. The Commissioners may require

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1 that they be graded, paved, [repaired or improved] REPAIRED, IMPROVED, OR 2 MAINTAINED, with curbs to be set and gutters laid, at the cost and expense of the 3 abutting real property or the owner; or compel by fine or otherwise the owner or 4 proprietor of any lot or parcel of land to [pave or repair] PAVE, REPAIR, OR 5 MAINTAIN sidewalks or footways and to set curbs and lay gutters in front of the 6 sidewalks.

7 (b) (1) THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO THE SNOW OR ICE 8 REMOVAL OR OTHER OBSTRUCTIONS OR HAZARDS OF SIDEWALKS.

9 (2) The County Commissioners, before proceeding to carry out the 10 provisions of this section, shall notify every owner in front of whose property they 11 propose to do any grading, paving, setting of curb, laying of gutters, or repairing and 12 shall allow the owners 30 days to perform the work under the direction of the County 13 Commissioners. If the owners fail or refuse to complete the work by the expiration 14 date on the notice, the County Commissioners may perform the work and its cost shall 15 be assessed against the owners in front of whose property the work was performed.

16 **[**(2)**]**(3) Whenever the County Commissioners have determined, 17 under the provisions of this section, the exact amount of cost for which any property or 18 the owners have been liable for work done or repairs made, they shall deliver to the County Treasurer a statement of the amount or amounts, together with the names of 19 20the respective owners of the property in front of which the work was done or the 21repairs were made. The County Treasurer shall enter upon the County Treasurer's 22books against each property mentioned in the statement the amount charged 23respectively to the property. This amount constitutes a lien on the particular parcel of 24property against which the amount is assessed. The County Treasurer shall notify each of the owners of the amount charged against the owner's property and proceed to 2526collect the amount in the same way and manner as taxes are collected for the county.

(C) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE MAINTENANCE OF SIDEWALKS BY ABUTTING REAL PROPERTY OWNERS FOR PURPOSES OF SNOW OR ICE REMOVAL OR OTHER OBSTRUCTIONS OR HAZARDS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 October 1, 2008.

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
