- 2 (a) Except as otherwise specifically provided in this subtitle it is unlawful for 3 any person to:
- 4 (1) Willfully intercept, endeavor to intercept, or procure any other 5 person to intercept or endeavor to intercept, any wire, oral, or electronic 6 communication;
- Willfully disclose, or endeavor to disclose, to any other person the contents of any wire, oral, or electronic communication, knowing or having reason to know that the information was obtained through the interception of a wire, oral, or electronic communication in violation of this subtitle; or
- 11 (3) Willfully use, or endeavor to use, the contents of any wire, oral, or 12 electronic communication, knowing or having reason to know that the information was 13 obtained through the interception of a wire, oral, or electronic communication in 14 violation of this subtitle.
- 15 (c) (11) It is lawful under this subtitle for a person to 16 Intercept a wire or electronic communication in order to secure 17 Evidence of a violation of the Maryland Consumer Debt Collection 18 Act (§§ 14–201 through 14–204 of the Commercial Law Article) or the 19 Maryland Telephone Consumer Protection Act (§§ 14–3201 and 20 14–3202 of the Commercial Law Article) if:
- 21 (I) THE PERSON IS A PARTY TO THE COMMUNICATION; AND
- 22 (II) THE COMMUNICATION IS MADE TO THE PERSON BY 23 ANOTHER PERSON FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEBT COLLECTION OR 24 TELEMARKETING.
- 25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 26 October 1, 2008.
