## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Transportation Trust Fund Protection Act**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the transfer or diversion of funds from the  
4 Transportation Trust Fund except under certain circumstances; requiring the  
5 Governor to make a certain declaration if funds are transferred or diverted from  
6 the Transportation Trust Fund; requiring the enactment of legislation providing  
7 for a certain repayment plan before funds are transferred or diverted from the  
8 Transportation Trust Fund; and generally relating to limiting transfers or  
9 diversions from the Transportation Trust Fund.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Transportation**

18 **3–217.**

19 **FUNDS IN THE TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND MAY NOT BE**  
20 **TRANSFERRED OR DIVERTED FROM THAT FUND TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE**  
21 **STATE UNLESS:**

1                   **(1) THE GOVERNOR DECLARES THE TRANSFER NECESSARY DUE**  
2 **TO EXTRAORDINARY FINANCIAL CIRCUMSTANCES; AND**

3                   **(2) LEGISLATION IS ENACTED PRIOR TO THE TRANSFER OR**  
4 **DIVERSION THAT PROVIDES FOR REPAYMENT OF THE FUNDS WITHIN 5 YEARS**  
5 **AFTER THE TRANSFER OR DIVERSION, WITH REPAYMENT COMMENCING**  
6 **IMMEDIATELY.**

7                   SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
8 July 1, 2008.
