## A BILL ENTITLED

1	AN ACT concerning

Crimes - Anabolic Steroids - Distribution to a Minor or Member of a High
School or College Athletic Team

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from unlawfully distributing, dispensing, or 5 possessing with intent to distribute an anabolic steroid to a minor or an 6 individual who the person knows or has reason to know is a member of a high 7 school or college athletic team; establishing penalties for a violation of this Act; 8 establishing a mandatory minimum penalty for a subsequent violation of this 9 Act; prohibiting a court from suspending the minimum sentence; establishing 10 that a person sentenced under this Act is not eligible for parole during the minimum sentence; establishing that a sentence imposed under this Act is 11 consecutive to any other sentence imposed; establishing that, notwithstanding 12 any other law, a conviction under this Act may not merge with a conviction 13 14 under certain other laws; and generally relating to anabolic steroids.
