Agriculture - Prohibited Acts - Force-Feeding Birds

FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from force-feeding birds to produce foie gras 3 or hiring another person to engage in force-feeding birds; prohibiting a person 4 5 from selling, transporting, or offering for sale any product that is the result of force-feeding birds to produce foie gras; prohibiting certain food service 6 establishments from serving or dispensing certain products that are the result 7 of force-feeding birds; providing for certain penalties for certain violations; 8 9 defining certain terms; and generally relating to a prohibition on force-feeding birds. 10

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 3 (3) "FOIE GRAS" MEANS THE LIVER OF A BIRD THAT HAS BEEN 4 SPECIALLY FATTENED BY THE FORCE-FEEDING OF THAT BIRD.
- 5 (4) "FOOD SERVICE OR DRINKING ESTABLISHMENT" MEANS A
 6 RESTAURANT, INN, BAR, TAVERN, OR ANY OTHER SIMILAR PLACE OF BUSINESS
 7 THAT OFFERS FOOD OR DRINK FOR SALE.
- 8 (5) (I) "FORCE-FEEDING A BIRD" MEANS A PROCESS BY WHICH
 9 A BIRD IS MADE TO CONSUME MORE THAN THE BIRD WOULD VOLUNTARILY
 10 CONSUME WHILE FORAGING FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENLARGING THE BIRD'S
 11 LIVER BEYOND ITS NORMAL SIZE.
- 12 (II) "FORCE-FEEDING A BIRD" INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT
 13 LIMITED TO, FORCING A TUBE OR OTHER APPARATUS INTO THE BEAK, BILL, OR
 14 THROAT OF A BIRD, OR BY ADMINISTERING DRUGS TO THE BIRD TO CAUSE THE
 15 BIRD TO OVERCONSUME FOR THE PRODUCTION OF FOIE GRAS.
- 16 (B) (1) A PERSON MAY NOT ENGAGE IN THE FORCE-FEEDING OF A
 17 BIRD, OR HIRE ANOTHER PERSON TO ENGAGE IN THE FORCE-FEEDING OF A
 18 BIRD, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENLARGING A BIRD'S LIVER BEYOND THE NORMAL
 19 SIZE TO PRODUCE FOIE GRAS.
- 20 (2) A PERSON MAY NOT SELL, TRANSPORT, OR OFFER FOR SALE,
 21 ANY PRODUCT THAT IS THE RESULT OF THE FORCE-FEEDING OF A BIRD FOR
 22 THE PURPOSE OF ENLARGING A BIRD'S LIVER BEYOND THE NORMAL SIZE TO
 23 PRODUCE FOIE GRAS.
- 24 (3) A FOOD SERVICE OR DRINKING ESTABLISHMENT MAY NOT SERVE OR DISPENSE ANY PRODUCT THAT IS THE RESULT OF FORCE-FEEDING A BIRD.
- 27 (C) A PERSON WHO KNOWINGLY VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF
 28 A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING
 29 \$1,000 FOR EACH DAY A VIOLATION OCCURS.
- 30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 31 June 1, 2008.
