SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF § 19–403 OF THIS SUBTITLE AND TITLE
 11 OF THIS ARTICLE, THE PREMIUM RATES FOR WORKERS' COMPENSATION
 INSURANCE:

20(1) SHALL BE DETERMINED BY THE NUMBER OF ACTUAL HOURS21WORKED IN EACH MANUAL RATE CLASSIFICATION; AND

22 (2) MAY NOT BE COMPUTED AS A PERCENTAGE OF AN 23 EMPLOYER'S PAYROLL.
