A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Comptroller - Eligibility for the Maryland Medical Assistance Program or the Maryland Children's Health Program

FOR the purpose of requiring the Comptroller to send a certain notice regarding eligibility for the Maryland Medical Assistance Program or the Maryland Children's Health Program to a certain taxpayer, if certain income reported on the income tax return does not exceed a certain amount; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to a notice about eligibility for certain health programs by the Comptroller.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Tax – General

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19(A)(1)IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE20MEANINGS INDICATED.

(2) "APPLICABLE POVERTY INCOME LEVEL" MEANS THE AMOUNT
 SPECIFIED IN THE POVERTY INCOME STANDARD THAT CORRESPONDS TO THE
 NUMBER OF EXEMPTIONS THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS ALLOWED AND CLAIMS
 UNDER § 10–211 OF THIS SUBTITLE.



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1 (3) "POVERTY INCOME STANDARD" MEANS THE MOST RECENT 2 POVERTY INCOME GUIDELINES PUBLISHED BY THE UNITED STATES 3 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, AVAILABLE AS OF JULY 1 OF 4 THE TAXABLE YEAR.

 $\mathbf{5}$ (4) **"TAXPAYER" MEANS:** 6 **(I)** AN INDIVIDUAL FILING AN INDIVIDUAL RETURN; OR $\mathbf{7}$ **(II)** A MARRIED COUPLE FILING A JOINT RETURN. 8 **(B)** IF THE FEDERAL ADJUSTED GROSS INCOME REPORTED ON THE 9 INCOME TAX RETURN OF A TAXPAYER WITH A DEPENDENT CHILD DOES NOT 10 EXCEED 300% OF THE APPLICABLE POVERTY INCOME LEVEL. THE 11 **COMPTROLLER SHALL SEND A NOTICE TO THE TAXPAYER:** 12(1) INDICATING THAT THE DEPENDENT CHILD MAY BE ELIGIBLE 13FOR THE MARYLAND MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM OR THE MARYLAND CHILDREN'S HEALTH PROGRAM; AND 14 15(2) PROVIDING INFORMATION ABOUT HOW TO ENROLL IN THE 16 **PROGRAMS.**

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 October 1, 2008, and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning after December
 31, 2008.

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
