1 AN ACT concerning

Task Force to Study Task Forces, Commissions, Temporary or Ad Hoc Committees, and Related Panels

- 4 FOR the purpose of establishing a Task Force to Study Task Forces, Commissions, $\mathbf{5}$ Temporary or Ad Hoc Committees, and Related Panels; providing for the membership of the Task Force; providing for the designation of a chair of the 6 7 Task Force; providing for staff for the Task Force; prohibiting a member of the 8 Task Force from receiving compensation; authorizing a member of the Task 9 Force to receive reimbursement for certain expenses; requiring the Task Force to study certain issues; requiring the Task Force to report its findings and 10 recommendations to the Governor and the General Assembly on or before a 11 certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to 12 13 the establishment of a Task Force to Study Task Forces, Commissions, Temporary or Ad Hoc Committees, and Related Panels. 14
- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16 MARYLAND, That:
- 17 (a) There is a Task Force to Study Task Forces, Commissions, Temporary or
 18 Ad Hoc Committees, and Related Panels.
- 19 (b) The Task Force consists of the following members:
- 20 (1) two members of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the 21 President of the Senate;
- (2) (2) two members of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker
 of the House;

19 20 21	(g) The Task Force shall report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § $2-1246$ of the State Government Article, the General Assembly on or before January 1, 2009.	
$22 \\ 23 \\ 24 \\ 25$	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2008. It shall remain effective for 1 year and, at the end of May 31, 2009, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
