A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Montgomery County - Alcoholic Beverages - Licenses Held by Revenue**
3 **Authority for Public Golf Courses**

4 **MC 807-08**

5 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Executive Director of the Montgomery County
6 Revenue Authority or the Executive Director's designee to hold certain alcoholic
7 beverages licenses for the limited use of public golf courses that are under the
8 jurisdiction of the Revenue Authority; specifying that certain licenses be signed
9 by the Executive Director or the Executive Director's designee; requiring the
10 Executive Director or the Executive Director's designee to designate individuals
11 to complete certain training; making certain stylistic changes; and generally
12 relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Montgomery County.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

22 (a) **(1)** The Director or Deputy Director of the Montgomery County Parks
23 Department of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission may
24 hold more than **[1] ONE** of the following alcoholic beverages licenses for the limited

1 use of public golf courses that are under the Commission's jurisdiction in Montgomery
2 County:

3 [(1)](I) A Class H beer (on-sale) license; or

4 [(2)](II) A Class H beer and light wine (on-sale) license.

5 **(2) THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY**
6 **REVENUE AUTHORITY OR THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S DESIGNEE MAY HOLD**
7 **MORE THAN ONE OF THE FOLLOWING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSES FOR**
8 **THE LIMITED USE OF PUBLIC GOLF COURSES THAT ARE UNDER THE**
9 **JURISDICTION OF THE REVENUE AUTHORITY:**

10 (I) **A CLASS H BEER(ON-SALE) LICENSE; OR**

11 (II) **A CLASS H BEER AND LIGHT WINE(ON-SALE) LICENSE.**

12 **(3) A LICENSE ISSUED UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS**
13 **SUBSECTION SHALL BE SIGNED BY THE REVENUE AUTHORITY'S EXECUTIVE**
14 **DIRECTOR OR THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S DESIGNEE.**

15 (b) (1) As a condition to holding any license under this section, the
16 Director or Deputy Director **OF THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY PARKS DEPARTMENT**
17 **OF THE MARYLAND-NATIONAL CAPITAL PARK AND PLANNING COMMISSION**
18 **OR THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY REVENUE**
19 **AUTHORITY OR THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S DESIGNEE, RESPECTIVELY,** shall
20 designate an individual with respect to each golf course to complete training in an
21 alcohol awareness program approved under § 13-101 of this article.

22 (2) The individual designated [by the Director or Deputy Director] **TO**
23 **COMPLETE TRAINING IN AN ALCOHOL AWARENESS PROGRAM UNDER**
24 **PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION** shall:

25 (i) Represent the concessionaire; and

26 (ii) Be involved with the management of the sale of beer or light
27 wine by the concessionaire at the golf course.

28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
29 July 1, 2008.
