A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Election Law – Prerecorded Phone Messages – Sponsor Identification**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from failing to ensure that certain messages
4 relating to a candidate, campaign, or political committee meet certain
5 requirements; prohibiting a person from sending a certain message that does
6 not contain certain information; providing for certain penalties for a willful and
7 knowing violation of the requirements of this Act; defining certain terms; and
8 generally relating to identification requirements for prerecorded or artificial
9 phone messages.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Election Law**

18 **16–904.**

19 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE
20 MEANINGS INDICATED.

21 (2) “ARTIFICIAL TELEPHONE MESSAGE” MEANS A TELEPHONE
22 MESSAGE CREATED USING A COMPUTER GENERATED VOICE.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.
[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 **(3) “PRERECORDED TELEPHONE MESSAGE” MEANS A**
2 **TELEPHONE MESSAGE THAT USES A HUMAN VOICE RECORDED IN ADVANCE OF**
3 **USE.**

4 **(B) A PERSON MAY NOT FAIL TO ENSURE THAT AN ARTIFICIAL**
5 **TELEPHONE MESSAGE OR A PRERECORDED TELEPHONE MESSAGE RELATING TO**
6 **A CANDIDATE, A PROSPECTIVE CANDIDATE, OR THE APPROVAL OR REJECTION**
7 **OF A QUESTION DURING OR AFTER THE MESSAGE, STATES CLEARLY THE**
8 **INFORMATION CONTAINED IN AN AUTHORITY LINE AS REQUIRED UNDER §**
9 **13-401 OF THIS ARTICLE.**

10 **(C) A PERSON WHO WILLFULLY AND KNOWINGLY VIOLATES THIS**
11 **SECTION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE CIVIL PENALTY PROVISIONS OF THE**
12 **MARYLAND TELEPHONE CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT.**

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
14 June 1, 2008.
