14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 (2) A MUNICIPALITY SHALL PROVIDE MATCHING FUNDS FOR 2 POLICE PROTECTION IN AN AMOUNT EQUIVALENT TO THE GRANT RECEIVED 3 UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 October 1, 2008.
